1. Presentation House theatre is located in North Vancouver on the unceded territories of the Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish) and Səlílwəta?/Selilwitulh (Tsleil-Waututh) nations. Here is a photo of the main entrance to the building when you come see a show. This entrance is on 4th Street. There are stairs and a wheelchair ramp to our entrance.




Here is another photo of the entrance to the building showing the wheelchair accessible ramp in more detail.



2. Where is Presentation House Theatre?

Presentation House theatre is located in North Vancouver on the unceded territories of the Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish) and Səlílwəta?/Selilwitulh (Tsleil-Waututh) nations. The building is located a few blocks from the Lonsdale Quay Seabus station. Here is a map of the area:



3. Driving and Parking

Our parking lot is located at the corner of 3rd and Chesterfield. We have two designated wheelchair accessible parking spots. There is also additional street parking on 4th.

To get from the parking lot to the theatre entrance on 4th Street, you can walk up the path beside the building, which has a few stairs, or use the sidewalk to go up the hill to the wheelchair ramp.




4. Bus

There are two bus stops close by. Stop number 54279 is right in front of our theatre on the North side of 3rd, west of Chesterfield, and routes 249 Delbrook and 255 Dundarave stop there, as well as the N24 Downtown Nightbus. Here is a photo of that bus stop:



The other bus stop nearby is stop number 60407, on the South side of 3rd Street, east of Chesterfield, and the 255 Capilano University bus stops there. Here is a photo of that bus stop:

Here is a photo of the lobby:



When you come inside the lobby, you will see a wheelchair accessible all genders washroom with a changing table for infants on your left. Here is a photo of the washroom.



There are two rooms off the lobby, here is a photo of the Weaving Room, which is on the right as you are coming in:



And here is a photo of the Second Floor Studio, which is on the left:



As you walk through the lobby, you will see a land acknowledgment video playing on a TV mounted on the wall. Above your head hangs a weaving by first nations artist Janice George. Here is a photo of the weaving.



Just past the weaving is our box office, where you can pick up your tickets. Here is a photo of the box office and our box office manager, Emily.



Continuing through the end of the lobby you will see the theatre entrance, and signs directing you to additional multiuser gender neutral washrooms, one with urinals and toilets and the other with just toilets, which are down the stairs on the first floor.



And lastly, the reason you are here in the first place, here is the entrance into the theatre, to the right of the stairs that go to the washrooms:



And here is the inside of the theatre, which may look different depending on which show we are producing.
